The Grace of Giving

Biible Texts: 2 Corithians 8:1-5, 7

INTRODUCTION

As Christians, God is interested in our prosperity and financial well-being. In 3 John 2, Apostle John, under the

inspiration of the Holy Spirit wrote "I wish above all things that you prosper and be in health even as your soul

prospers. This means that God wants us, not only to prosper physically, emotionally and spiritually but also

financially. However, the key to God's financial prosperity is by giving according to Bible principles.

THE FOUNDATION OF CHRISTIAN GIVING

Acceptable biblical giving is based on acknowledgement of God and His provision of salvation by grace. Grace is

unmerited favour that proceeds from God's unconditional love. God demonstrated His grace by giving up Jesus as a

sacrifice for the redemption of mankind. As recipients of God's grace, we must be willing to give promptly and

liberally like the Macedonian Christians described in our Bible text.

WHY DO WE GIVE? : We give because:

1. We give in obedinece to God. We give because we love God and others (Lk 6: 38, 1John 3:17)

2. It is more more blessed to give than to receive (Act 20:35)

3. We want to build and expand the Kingdom of God on earth. (Haggai 1:2-11)

4. We want to finance the preaching of the gospel and missionary activities (Acts11: 29)

5. We want to uplift the poor and the needy. (Deut 15:11;Prov.14:21b)

WHAT DO WE GIVE?

1. Money (Act 4:32-35)

2. Material things such as food, clothing, shoes, vehicles, properties etc (James 2:15-17, Prov 22: 9)

3. The totality of ourselves: our life, time, energy; skills and expertise (Rom 12:1-2; Galatians 2:20)

HOW SHOULD WE GIVE?

1. Give in humility (Matthew 6:1-4)

2. Give cheerfully and willingly (2 Corith 9:7)

3. Give liberally and generously (Prov.21:26; 2 Corinthians 9:10-11; Romans 12:8)

4. Give sacrificially (Luke 21:4; 2 Samuel 24:24.)

5. Give according to our ability (Deut 16:17; 2 Corithians 8:12).

CONCLUSION

Giving is the flow line to financial prosperity. The more you give, the more you receive. Giving must not be an

occasional exercise but a continous daily lifestyle made in obedience to God's commandment .We must look for

every opportunity to give. As you invest in people and the work of God through giving, the more the rewards you
